**Navigating from Peak to Peak**

**Peak 7 to Peak 8:**  
Note the Independence SuperChair™ closes at 4:00 pm. Exit Peak 7 via Chairjumper. Alternate route is to ride the BreckConnect Gondola from the base of Peak 7 to Peak 8 base.

**Peak 8 to Peak 7:**  
Follow Columbine to Pioneer, take Pioneer to the Independence SuperChair™. Alternate route is to ride the BreckConnect Gondola from the base of Peak 8 to Peak 7 base.

**Peak 8 to Peak 9:**  
From the top of 5-Chair follow Four O'Clock to Sawmill to the base of Peak 9.  
From the Vista Haus follow Springmeier to Four O'Clock to Crescent to base of Peak 9.  
From the Vista Haus follow Frosty's Freeway to E-Chair to Peak 9 Summit.

**Peak 9 to Peak 10:**  
Follow Briar Rose or Cashier and lower Country Boy to base of the Falcon SuperChair™.

**Peak 10 to Peak 9:**  
From the base of the Falcon SuperChair™ follow Red Rover to Beaver Run SuperChair™.

**Peaks 9 and 10 to Peak 8:**  
Follow Bonanza to Lower Sundown and take the Peak 8 SuperConnect™.  
Follow Red Rover to Lower Sundown and take the Peak 8 SuperConnect™.  
Follow Upper Peak 8 Transfer to the Peak 8 SuperConnect™ Midway Load.
